



Mentors Wanted

The Brevard Schools Foundation Take Stock in Children (TSIC) program is actively seeking mentors throughout the county, *with the greatest need in the Palm Bay area*. The Take Stock in Children program provides a unique opportunity for local students (in grades 7-10) to escape the cycle of poverty through education, mentoring and college readiness. Together with our community, we are able to provide a 2-year college scholarship to our students who successfully complete the program. Students are matched with a volunteer mentor and must commit to remain drug and crime-free, maintain a GPA of 2.5 and pass mandatory state tests.

Mentors are caring adults with “more to give”. Mentors meet with students once a week and provide the needed encouragement, guidance and support to help students realize the dream of a college education. All mentoring takes place at school, during school hours. The commitment is to meet for about 30 minutes a week with the student for the entire school year.
