

Space Coast Women In Defense Board Nominations

It is that time of year again! The Space Coast Chapter of Women In Defense (SCWID) is currently taking nominations of persons to serve on the Board of Directors (BoD) for the term which runs October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. The SCWID BoD consists of four (4) Officers and seven (7) Directors. We seek the most qualified candidates that are current SCWID members in good standing for each of the board positions. Each nominee is expected to attend monthly board meetings and all membership meetings. Currently, we are looking for the open Director positions listed below to join the board. However, any of the 11 BoD positions can accept nominations as they are one-year terms with a two-year term limit. Responsibilities for all positions will be provided upon request. OPEN POSITIONS:

Treasurer

The Treasurer prepares the SCWID budget. The Treasurer reports on budget execution and other matters as directed by the BoD. The Treasurer will be the recipient of external requests for funding/support and coordinated with the chapter's champion until which time the finance committee determines action on that request. The nominee should be a member in good standing for at least two years and have served as an elected board member for at least one of those years on either the National or a Chapter Board.

Membership

The Membership Director will solicit a committee of members to enforce both Recruitment and Retention in accordance with the WID Chapter Management Manual, section 2. Recruitment encompasses promoting membership and facilitating membership drives. Retention will included keeping the chapter sustainable, communication with members and providing reminders accordingly. Monthly reports will be provided during Board of Director meetings. The nominee should be a member in good standing for at least one year.

Programs

The Programs Director will solicit a committee of members to facilitate the planing and execution of chapter sponsored events. This will include, but not be limited to networking events, speaker engagements, fundraisers, scholarship programs, conferences and support to local/national events. The nominee should be a member in good standing for at least one year.

Sponsorships

The Sponsorships Director is responsible for finding sponsors for the monthly meetings and to draft and update the Sponsorship level package.

Helps with sponsorships for the golf tournament for STEM promotion. Works with the Program Director and Awards and Recognition Director to promote funding for the programs. The nominee should be a member in good standing for at least one year.

Instructions for Nominations: Self Nominations are encouraged. Nominees need to forward 1) a resume to the Election Committee along with 2) a statement of intent indicating the office/director seat that they seek and 3) their vision for SCWID.
